## **The Solemnity of Corpus Christi, The Body and Blood of Christ**

This weekend, the Church throughout the world celebrates the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ. We believe in the real presence of Jesus - body, soul, and divinity - in the Blessed Sacrament. In every Church where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved there is a candle burning. The candle says: Yes, Our Lord Jesus is with us; Yes, God is present here and in every corner of the world. The Eucharist is the gift our Lord Jesus gave to us the night before he died when Jesus said: "This is my body... this is my Blood, do this in memory of me."

Today, (Sunday) the parishes in the City of Camden will once again come together for a Eucharistic Procession through the city. The procession will begin at 1:00 p.m. at Sacred Heart Church and proceed down Broadway to the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. From the Cathedral the procession will continue up Federal Street to St. Joseph's Pro-Cathedral, arriving at approximately 3:00 p.m., for final prayers and benediction. Camden Metro Police will escort those in procession. The total walk is approximately 3.5 miles. For those who do not want to walk you may join us in your vehicle and drive behind those walking. Cars are asked to line up on Ferry Avenue in Camden near Sacred Heart Church by 12:45 p.m. A bus will transport walkers back to Sacred Heart Church at the end of the procession.

O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment thine.

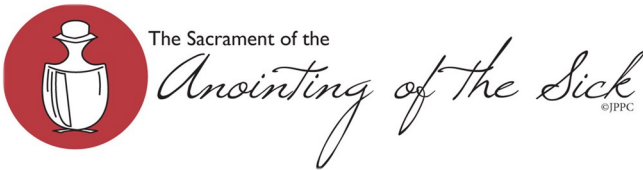

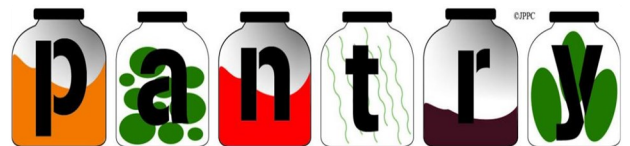

**Coadjutor Bishop assigned to Diocese**

CAMDEN — "Say yes to the God of surprises."  
Bishop Joseph A. Williams shared this wisdom he gleaned from his parents as he addressed a news conference May 21 introducing him as the first Coadjutor Bishop of Camden.  
"Bloom where you're planted," the native Middletown said, quoting his mother. "I've always tried to do that as a priest. I've never tried to chart my own course. You say yes to the Church and to the Lord when they ask. Now, I get an opportunity to bloom here in South Jersey."  
Bishop Williams, 50, who was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis in 2002, addressed Catholic and secular media during the morning news conference held in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. The event, which came hours after his appointment by Pope Francis was made public, was livestreamed on all diocesan media.  
Diocesan priests and staff stood and applauded as Bishop Dennis Sullivan introduced the new coadjutor. "When I greeted the Bishop at the airport... I greeted him in the words of my Irish mother, 'Fáilte' — a hundred thousand welcomes," Bishop Sullivan said. "I sincerely mean that."  
Bishop Sullivan, who served as a priest and auxiliary bishop in New York before his 2013 appointment to the Diocese of Camden, submitted his (continued on page 4)

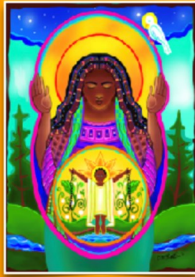

## *La Solemnidad de Corpus Christi, El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo*

Este fin de semana la Iglesia en todo el mundo celebra la Eucaristía, el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Creemos en la presencia real de Jesús - cuerpo, alma y divinidad - en el Santísimo Sacramento. En cada Iglesia donde se reserva el Santísimo Sacramento hay una vela encendida. La vela dice: Sí, Nuestro Señor Jesús está con nosotros; Sí, Dios está presente aquí. En todos los rincones del mundo: en Roma, en Jerusalén, en México, en El Salvador, y aquí en nuestra parroquia arde una vela en las Iglesias de San Lorenzo y San Lucas y nos dice que Dios está presente aquí, no tengas miedo. La procesión comenzará a las 1:00 p.m. en la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón y continué por Broadway hasta la Catedral de la Inmaculada Concepción. Desde la Catedral, la procesión continuará por Federal Street hasta la Pro-Catedral de San José, llegando aproximadamente a las 3:00 p.m., para las oraciones finales y la bendición. La Policía Metropolitana de Camden escoltará a los que estén en procesión. La caminata total es de aproximadamente 3.5 millas. Para aquellos que no quieran caminar, pueden unirse a nosotros en su vehículo y conducir detrás de los que caminan. Se pide a los automóviles que se alineen en Ferry Avenue en Camden, cerca de la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón, antes de las 12:45 p.m. Un autobús transportará a los caminantes de regreso a la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón al final de la procesión.

Oh Santísimo Sacramento, oh Divino Sacramento, toda alabanza y toda acción de gracias sean tuyas en todo momento.
