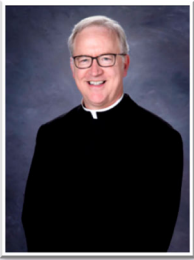

## From the Pastor's Desk

### ***THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT...JESUS IS TEMPTED***

On this First Sunday of Lent, the Gospel is always about the Temptations of Jesus in the desert. Jesus does not fall when he is tempted. He is loyal to his Father in Heaven, and does not sin.

For you and me, however, it is difficult. The evil one tempts us and knows our weaknesses. The temptations of the Capital Sins are always knocking on our door. *Pride, Greed, Lust, Anger, Sloth, Gluttony, Envy.* We are human and weak. We fall to the temptations of Satan. That is why Lent is very important. Lent is a time to renew your faith. To renew your spirit. A time to grow close to God, and to permit Jesus to live in you.

My dear friends, do not be afraid of confession. Confession is a beautiful sacrament of God's love and mercy. Admit your weakness and confess. Receive God's mercy.

One of my favorite movies is about St. Thomas More and is called, *A Man for All Seasons.* (*Thomas More was a lawyer, so yes, he is a favorite of mine!*) In one scene, Thomas talks about sin. He said: A person often does not give his soul away all at once, but very often it is bit by bit. Yes, this is very true. We give our soul to Satan a little at a time. A small lie, bad words, gossip, lust, anger, and before you know it these "little sins," if not checked, lead to bigger sins. Small sins can lead to more serious sins and we turn away from the Church and from the Lord. Often, the more we sin, the more we justify our actions. As a boat slowly drifts off into the horizon at sea, so our soul can drift away from God.

Together, let's allow this season of Lent to be a time to examine our conscience and to make sure we do not slowly drift away from God. God does not tire of forgiving; thus, we should not tire of asking for mercy. I pray that the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be a part of your Lenten plan this holy season.

### Baptism

The sacrament of Baptism is the first step in a lifelong journey of commitment and discipleship. Whether we are baptized as infants or adults, Baptism is the Church's way of celebrating and enacting the embrace of God.

### Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is a ritual of healing appropriate not only for physical but also for mental and spiritual sickness.

### Holy Matrimony

The Sacrament of Marriage, or Holy Matrimony, is a public sign that one gives oneself totally to this other person. It is also a public statement about God: the loving union of husband and wife speaks of family values and also God's values. Ideally, marriage preparation should be made a year in advance and Catholic marriages take place during Mass.

## First Sunday of Lent (Matthew 4:1-11)

At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil.

He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was hungry.

The tempter approached and said to him,

"If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become loaves of bread."

He said in reply,

"It is written:

*One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God."*

Then the devil took him to the holy city, and made him stand on the parapet of the temple, and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down.

For it is written:

*He will command his angels concerning you and with their hands they will support you, lest you dash your foot against a stone."*

Jesus answered him,

"Again it is written,

*You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test."*

Then the devil took him up to a very high mountain, and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in their magnificence,

and he said to him, "All these I shall give to you, if you will prostrate yourself and worship me."

At this, Jesus said to him,

It is written:

*The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve."*

Then the devil left him and, behold, angels came and ministered to him.

### ***Lectio Divina Questions to pray with this week:***

- \* Lent begins and we are called to the three Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Which of these is hardest for you? Which is easier to practice? Discuss this with a member of your family or friend.
- \* What can you do to make this Lenten Season a time to grow in your relationship to Christ?
- \* Jesus resisted the Devil's temptation. Pray for the grace to make a good confession this Lent.

## Primer Domingo de Cuaresma (Mateo 4:1-11)

# Sacred Heart Parish Celebrates Black History Month

### Venerable Father Augustus Tolton Perseverance in the Face of Adversity

Augustus was born in the U.S. to two slaves. Tolton's father escaped to the North at the beginning of the Civil War, where he served in the Union Army and was killed in the war. His widow sought freedom, and managed to cross the Mississippi River and settled in the small town of Quincy.

When her children attempted to attend Catholic school to be educated by the Sisters of Notre Dame, parents of the other school children protested, so the Sisters of Notre Dame decided to tutor the Tolton children privately.

As Augustus grew older he began to display an interest in the priesthood. Denied entrance to diocesan seminaries, Tolton's parish priests began Augustus' education in theology themselves. Finally in 1878, the Franciscan College in Quincy accepted Augustus, and two years later he was enrolled at the college of the Propaganda Fidei in Rome.

Augustus Tolton was ordained on April 24, 1886. His first assignment was Saint Joseph parish in Quincy, where he served for two years and gained enormous respect from many of the German and Irish parishioners. He was later given a parish on the south side of the city, Saint Augustine (later St. Monica's). This would be Fr. Tolton's parish for life, and the center from which he ministered to all the Black Catholics of Chicago. He addressed the First Catholic Colored Congress in Washington DC in 1889.

The cause for Fr. Tolton's canonization was begun in 2010. In 2015, the cause received affirmation of the juridical validity of the Archdiocesan inquiry into his life and virtues by the Congregation for Causes of Saints, and Fr. Tolton received the distinction of Servant of God.

### Servant of God Julia Greeley Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Denver's Angel of Charity was born into slavery at Hannibal, Missouri, between 1833 and 1848. As a young child, Julia's right eye was destroyed when a cruel slave master's whip, intended for her mother, also caught her.

Freed by the Emancipation Proclamation in 1863, Julia subsequently earned her keep by serving white families in Missouri, Colorado, Wyoming, and New Mexico—though mostly in the Denver area. She spent whatever she could spare to assist poor families in her neighborhood. When her own resources were inadequate, she begged for food, fuel, and clothing for the needy. To avoid embarrassing the people she helped, Julia did most of her charitable work under cover of night through dark alleys.

Julia entered the Catholic Church at Sacred Heart Parish in Denver in 1880. The Jesuits who ran the parish considered her the most enthusiastic promoter of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus they had ever seen. Every month she went on foot to every fire station in Denver and delivered literature of the Sacred Heart League to the firemen, Catholics and non-Catholics alike.

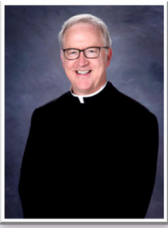
Julia had a rich devotion to the Blessed Sacrament and the Blessed Virgin. She was a daily communicant and continued her prayers while working and moving about. She joined the Secular Franciscan Order in 1901 and was active in it until her death in 1918.

To the present day, many people have asked that her cause be opened for canonization. This request was finally granted in the Fall of 2016. As part of the Cause for Canonization, Julia's mortal remains were transferred to Denver's Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception on June 7, 2017.

Uno de mis películas favoritas es sobre Santo Thomas More y se llama *Un Hombre para Todas las Temporadas*. (Thomas More era abogado, así que sí, ¡es uno de mis favoritos!) En una escena, Thomas habla sobre el pecado. Él dijo: Una persona a menudo no entrega su alma de una sola vez, pero muy a menudo es poco a poco. Sí, esto es muy cierto. Damos nuestra alma a Satanás poco a poco. Una pequeña mentira, malas palabras, chismes, lujuria, ira y, antes de que te des cuenta, estos “pequeños pecados”, si no se controlan, conducen a pecados más grandes. Los pecados pequeños pueden conducir a pecados más graves y nos alejamos de la Iglesia y del Señor. A menudo, cuanto más pecamos, más justificamos nuestras acciones. Así como un barco se aleja lentamente hacia el horizonte en el mar, así nuestra alma puede alejarse de Dios.

Juntos, hagamos que la Temporada de Cuaresma sea un tiempo de examinación de conciencia y de asegurarnos de que no nos alejemos lentamente de Dios. Dios no se cansa de perdonar; por lo tanto, no debemos cansarnos de pedir misericordia. Oro para que el Sacramento de la Reconciliación sea parte de tu plan de Cuaresma en esta Temporada Santa.
