This weekend, of course, as the country celebrates Father's Day, my Dad is on my mind in a special way. My Dad and I had a wonderful relationship and being the single son, I spent a lot of time with Dad. In many ways Dad became my best friend as Dad got older and I matured. Whether it was fishing, golfing, watching the Phillies and Eagles, laughing at a Seinfeld rerun or waiting for my Mom at a local mall, we spent countless hours together. Dad was also an amazing Grandfather or "Pop-Pop" as he was lovingly known. I can still hear him laughing and singing and stirring up my nieces and nephews with a made-up song or game.

We learn from our parents. I believe I learned humility and gentleness from my Mom. My Dad taught me and my siblings the importance of education and to strive for excellence. My Mom would often joke and say we got our looks from her and our brains from our Dad. Dear Parishioners:

Sacred Heart Parish operates with a structural deficit, meaning that regular offertory and operating revenues alone do not cover the full cost of parish ministries, worship, and parish-wide operations. However, through the generosity of donors, successful fundraising efforts, and other charitable contributions, we have been able to close this gap and maintain financial stability. While these efforts have enabled us to balance our finances and continue serving our communities, they cannot be viewed as a guaranteed solution. Fundraising results fluctuate, and donor support can change from year to year.

**To secure the future of our parish**, we must strengthen our recurring sources of revenue, particularly offertory giving and parish stewardship. The responsibility for sustaining our mission belongs to all of us. By increasing participation, encouraging regular tithing, and exploring new revenue opportunities, we can build a more stable financial future and reduce our dependence on uncertain funding sources.

Thank you for all of your financial and spiritual support. Through your faithful support we will continue to make Sacred Heart Parish and our 3 church communities **BEACONS OF HOPE** in South Camden.

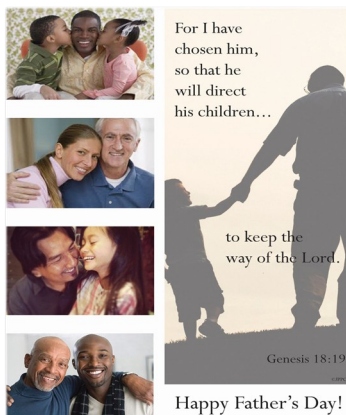

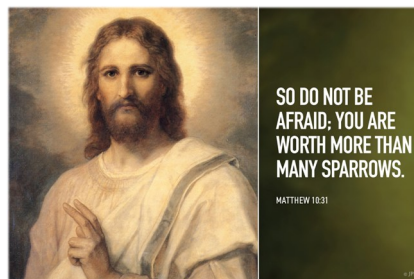

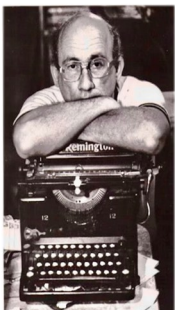

## ¡FELIZ DÍA DEL PADRE!

¡Feliz Día del Padre! Como he mencionado muchas veces en homilias y conversaciones con los feligreses, no pasa un día sin que piense en mi Mamá y en mi Papá.

Este fin de semana, por supuesto, mientras el país celebra el Día del Padre, tengo a mi papá muy presente de una manera especial. Mi Papá y yo tuvimos una relación maravillosa y, al ser hijo único, pasé mucho tiempo con él. En muchos sentidos, Papá se convirtió en mi mejor amigo a medida que él envejecía y yo maduraba. Ya fuera pescando, jugando al golf, viendo los partidos de los Phillies y los Eagles, riéndonos con una reposición de Seinfeld o esperando a mi Mamá en un centro comercial local, pasamos incontables horas juntos. Papá también fue un abuelo increíble, o “Pop-Pop”, como lo llamábamos cariñosamente. Todavía puedo escucharlo reír, cantar y alborotar a mis sobrinos con alguna canción o juego inventado.

Aprendemos de nuestros padres. Creo que aprendí la humildad y la gentileza de mi Mamá. Mi Papá nos enseñó a mis hermanos y a mí la importancia de la educación y de esforzarnos por alcanzar la excelencia. Mi mamá solía bromear diciendo que habíamos heredado el físico de ella y la inteligencia de Papá. Mi Papá era inteligente, aunque no terminó la secundaria (más tarde obtuvo su certificado de equivalencia, el GED) porque dejó los estudios para alistarse en el ejército al final de la Segunda Guerra Mundial. Quería ir a la universidad después de la guerra, pero terminó usando el dinero de su ayuda para veteranos (GI Bill) para ayudar a sus padres, que tenían escasos recursos, a pagar su hipoteca. Papá se hizo policía de Filadelfia, se casó con Mamá y formó una familia. Inculcó en mis hermanos y en mí el afán por la educación y el servicio. No es de extrañar que los cinco tengamos títulos de posgrado. Papá creía en nosotros y nos infundía la confianza de que podíamos lograr cualquier cosa que nos propusiéramos. Se sentía muy orgulloso cuando alguno de sus hijos o nietos alcanzaba una meta. Recuerdo que mi mamá admiraba que papá nunca hablara mal de nadie. Y es verdad: Papá siempre encontraba lo mejor en cada persona, especialmente en aquellas que atravesaban momentos difíciles. Mamá y Papá nos enseñaron nuestra fe con palabras y con el ejemplo. Nuestra fe Católica era parte del aire que respirábamos en casa. Papá, feliz Día del Padre.



Gracias por todo lo que hiciste por mí y por la familia. Los extraño a ti y a Mamá todos los días. Rueguen por mí desde el cielo y ayúdenme a ser un sacerdote que los haga sentir orgullosos a ti y a Mamá. Un día volveremos a estar juntos. ¡Feliz Día del Padre!
