Take Courage, Do Not Be Afraid

Today's Gospel begins in the middle of a storm. (Matthew 14:22-33). The disciples are in a boat. The wind is strong, the waves are high, and they are afraid. Then Jesus comes toward them, walking on the water. At first, they do not recognize him. But Jesus says: "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." Peter steps out of the boat. As long as his eyes are fixed on Jesus, he walks on the water. But when he notices the wind and the waves, he becomes afraid and begins to sink. Then Peter prays one of the shortest and most powerful prayers in the Bible: "Lord, save me!"

This weekend, as we celebrate the 50th anniversary of Mother Teresa's visit to Sacred Heart Church, we remember a woman who also heard the call of Jesus: "Come." Mother Teresa had the courage to step out of the boat. She left behind comfort and security to serve the poorest of the poor. She entered places of suffering, sickness, loneliness, and death. She saw people whom the world had forgotten, and she reached out her hand to them. In doing so, she was reaching out and grasping the hand of Jesus. Mother Teresa believed that Christ was present in every suffering person. The hand of the poor person was the hand of Jesus. Mother Teresa could not help every suffering person in the world. But she helped the person in front of her. She offered small acts of love, one person at a time.

That is also our calling. The greatest way to honor Mother Teresa is not only to remember that she visited Sacred Heart fifty years ago. It is to continue her mission. The storms of life will come. The wind may be strong, and our faith may sometimes feel weak. But Jesus still comes toward us. He still says, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." He still reaches out his hand. May the example of Mother Teresa give us the courage to take his hand and then to extend our hands to others with compassion, mercy, and love.

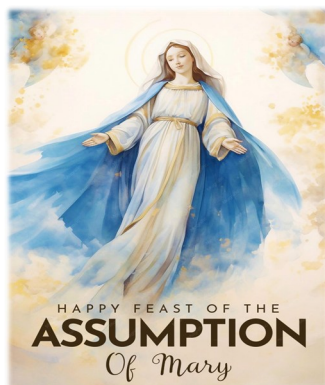

ÁNIMO, NO TENGAN MIEDO

El Evangelio de hoy comienza en medio de una tormenta (Mateo 14, 22-33). Los discípulos están en una barca. El viento es fuerte, las olas son altas y tienen miedo. Entonces Jesús se acerca a ellos caminando sobre el agua. Al principio, no lo reconocen. Pero Jesús les dice: “Ánimo, soy yo; no tengan miedo”. Pedro baja de la barca. Mientras mantiene la mirada fija en Jesús, camina sobre el agua. Pero al notar el viento y las olas, siente miedo y comienza a hundirse. Entonces Pedro pronuncia una de las oraciones más breves y poderosas de la Biblia: “¡Señor, sálvame!”.

Este fin de semana, al celebrar el 50.º Aniversario de la visita de la Madre Teresa a la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón, recordamos a una mujer que también escuchó la llamada de Jesús: “Ven”. La Madre Teresa tuvo la valentía de bajar de la barca. Dejó atrás la comodidad y la seguridad para servir a los más pobres de entre los pobres. Entró en lugares de sufrimiento, enfermedad, soledad y muerte. Vio a personas que el mundo había olvidado y les tendió la mano. Al hacerlo, estaba tendiendo la mano y aferrándose a la mano de Jesús. La Madre Teresa creía que Cristo estaba presente en cada persona que sufría. La mano del pobre era la mano de Jesús. La Madre Teresa no podía ayudar a todas las personas que sufrían en el mundo, pero ayudaba a la persona que tenía delante. Ofrecía pequeños actos de amor, a una persona cada vez.

Esa es también nuestra llamada. La mejor manera de honrar a la Madre Teresa no es solo recordar que visitó el Sagrado Corazón hace cincuenta años, sino continuar su misión. Las tormentas de la vida llegarán. El viento puede ser fuerte y nuestra fe puede parecer débil a veces. Pero Jesús sigue viniendo hacia nosotros. Sigue diciendo: “Ánimo, soy yo; no tengan miedo”. Sigue tendiéndonos la mano. Que el ejemplo de la Madre Teresa nos dé el valor para tomar su mano y luego tender las nuestras a los demás con compasión, misericordia y amor.
