



Post-Treatment Instructions: Keeping Your Home Roach-Free

Following a German cockroach treatment, it's crucial to take steps to continue the fight. Here is how you can help maintain a roach-free environment:

Cleaning:

- **Wait for it to dry:** Don't clean treated areas for at least **72 hours** (or as instructed by the technician) to allow the product time to work effectively.
- **Focus on sanitation:** After the waiting period, thoroughly clean floors, countertops, and shelves with soapy water or a disinfectant solution. Pay close attention to areas behind appliances and in corners.
- **Vacuum regularly:** Vacuum floors, baseboards, and under furniture at least once a week. Dispose of the vacuum bag immediately after use.
- **Dishes:** Wash dishes promptly, and avoid leaving dirty dishes in the sink overnight.
- **Beware of clutter:** Reduce clutter in your home to minimize potential hiding spots for roaches.

Eliminate food sources:

- **Store food properly:** Keep food in sealed containers or in the refrigerator. Do not leave crumbs or spills on countertops or floors.
- **Fix leaky faucets:** Address any leaky pipes or dripping faucets to eliminate moisture sources for roaches.
- **Empty trash regularly:** Don't let garbage accumulate. Take out trash cans frequently and keep them sealed tightly.

Long-Term Prevention:

- **Store boxes and clothing off the floor:** Elevate boxes and other stored items to prevent roaches from hiding underneath.
