



Preparing for Your German Cockroach Treatment

To ensure a successful treatment and minimize disruption, please follow these steps before your scheduled appointment:

Kitchen and Pantry:

- **Empty cabinets and drawers:** Remove all food, dishes, utensils, and cookware. Place them in sealed containers or in the refrigerator.
