- **Parent portal:**

1. Register on Jackrabbit “Parent Portal”

- All clients are ***required to put a credit card or debit card*** on their account in the Parent Portal when registering a child.

5. Tuition

- Class are billed monthly, prices are as follows:
 - \$65 monthly for 45 minutes class one a week.
 - \$70 monthly for an hour class once a week.
 - \$75 monthly for one hour and 15 minutes once a week.
 - \$80 monthly for hour and a half classes once a week.
 - \$85 monthly for hour and 45 minutes classes once a week.
 - Private lessons are \$75 an hour.
 - 5% sibling discount off of youngest child's classes
- **All tuition is due by the 1st of each month. Statements will be sent out on the 15th of each month. Late notices and a late fee of \$25 will go out on the 2nd of each month.**
- Your card on file will be charged on the 4th of the month if tuition has not been paid on time.
- **Auto-draft** each month by letting Mrs. Sarah know through email at the beginning of the school year. *This is the simplest way to pay your tuition.*
- **If you become two months behind on tuition, you may be asked to leave the studio**
- **Please note if you do not pay for costumes or recital fees, your child is not allowed to participate in the show and maybe asked to leave the studio.**
- **All recitals are optional, but highly encouraged**

6. Production Fee and Costumes for Spring Review 2026 (show date May 16th)

- Production fee **\$250** per family , due **February 1, 2026**
- This will include 4 free tickets per family and 1 free digital review book per family
- review tights for each child.

- Costume fees will be charged in **3 payments on your monthly statement**, due **September 1, October 1 and November 1, 2025**. The same rules apply to costume fees as tuition. If the costume fee is not paid by the 4th of the month your card will be charged.

7. Production Fee for Christmas Review 2025. (show date: December 19th 7:00-8:00)

- The production fee is **\$200**
- **per family** and is due **September 1, 2025**
- This will include 4 free tickets per family

7. Dress Code

All uniforms and shoes must be purchased from GTTP.

30% discount for all uniforms for **returning students** from 2024/2025 dance season. Please note we have open house sales throughout the summer for uniforms! It is extremely important that students have

proper dancewear on and shoes to help them achieve the best that they can in the studio.

GTTP uniforms include tights with an attached skirt or non-attached shorts, depending on what class. All uniforms must be worn in class at all times.

❖ Attendance

PLEASE DO NOT DROP YOUR CHILD OFF EARLY. THERE WILL BE NO ONE TO WATCH THEM. WE DO NOT OFFER CHILD CARE SERVICES.

- For your child's safety, we will lock the front door during class. Please have your child dressed and ready for class. Please **do not** drop your child off earlier.
- If a student has to miss class, they are required to notify Mrs. Sarah Ochs Ranson. through email, beforehand. Roll will be taken in each class. Attendance is very important for each dancer to progress in their skills to the next level. If your child has missed up to 7 classes please contact us to see if we need to schedule a private session. So your child can participate in the reviews. Review Dances are learned throughout the fall and spring session. Attendance is highly important to attend as much as possible to be prepared for a review.
- If a child has missed over 15 classes during fall or spring sessions with no contact to schedule a private lesson, the child may be asked not to participate in review.

Refunds

*we do not give out any refunds at GTTP

* please note that the 2025-2026 dance season goes from August 11th- May 16th!

Rules and regulations

If a **student and / or parent** continuously breaks the rules and regulations of the studio they will be asked to leave.

Conduct and behavior

- We expect parents and students to be respectful to all teachers and owners as well as other students and parents. This goes for inside the studio and outside of the studio.
- We do not tolerate any inappropriate behavior from students or parents towards any faculty member, owner or other students. This includes raising voices, arguing, name calling, or disrespect of any kind.
- Bullying of any kind is not tolerated.
- If there are any questions or concerns or conflict. We are more than happy to schedule a meeting outside of your child's normal classroom hours.

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What's required of you at GTTP

- We ask all parents to pay on time. If there are any reasons you cannot pay your bill on time please contact us and we are more than willing to work with you. However, if there's no communication after two months. You'll be asked to leave the studio.
- We require that all students have a proper dance uniform and dance shoes for every class.
- Hair is to be pulled up in a ponytail or bun for every class.
 ***If the student continuously does not have the proper shoes or uniform, and we have to approach parents about this conflict more than three times, the student may be asked to leave the studio.
- We ask all parents and students to be polite to all faculty members, owners, and other parents and students. We do not tolerate any gossip, bullying, or outbursts of anger. If any of these behaviors are presented, you may be asked to leave the studio.
- We ask all parents to please drop their child off in the lobby at the correct time. **No parents are allowed in the lobby at any time.** This is for the children's safety. We do not have a waiting room. We also lock the front door the whole time to keep everyone safe that is in the studio.
- We ask all parents to ***please email, call or text with any questions.***
 - Please **do not interrupt any faculty member during or in between classes** to ask questions. This is time for us to make sure everyone gets in and out of the studio properly and has full attention during their time.
