A BILL

To direct the President of the United States to designate one month each year as Fidelity Month for the purpose of rededicating our Nation to the values of faith, family, and patriotism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS.**

4 Congress finds the following:

5 (1) A recent opinion poll of Americans showed
6 support for traditional values has significantly de-
7 clined.

1 (2) A majority of Americans no longer view val-
2 ues like faith, family, patriotism, or being involved
3 in the community as very important.

4 (3) These values used to unite Americans.

5 (4) The decline in these values has cor-
6 responded with a rise in crime, drug abuse, alien-
7 ation, and family disintegration.

8 (5) Fidelity means dedication to faith, spouses
9 and families, and our country and communities.

10 (6) Citizens of all faiths can join in recommit-
11 ting our Nation to fidelity.

12 (7) Our Founding Father John Adams said,
13 “Our Constitution was made only for a moral and
14 religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the gov-
15 ernment of any other.”.

16 (8) Our survival as a country depends on the
17 shared bonds of faith, family, and patriotism.

18 (9) It is fitting to observe a month of rededi-
19 cating our Nation to our core values.

20 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF FIDELITY MONTH BY THE PRESI-**
21 **DENT.**

22 The President shall designate one month each year
23 as Fidelity Month for the purpose of rededicating our Na-
24 tion to the values of faith, family, and patriotism.
