課程目標：

學員在這課程中一方面會認識及理解路加福音中的主要課題與神學思想，以及這書卷與使徒行傳的密切關係，另一方面亦會透過認識及欣賞路加的寫作手法，從而可以更好的掌握全書的主題與思想脈絡。

課程內容：

路加福音並不是一本單單記載耶穌生平事蹟的書，它是一部富有文學色彩的作品。路加對耶穌的事蹟經過仔細的查證，有著一定程度的資料搜集，但這部作品的特色不單

單在於資料上的正確無誤，更在於書中可見的表達方式、文學色彩。正如路加於前言所述的，他是將所得的資料按著‘次序’表達出來，這‘次序’是與所得資料的選用與否、不同事件的敘述次序與所佔用的篇幅、不同人物的描述等等有著密切的關係。本課程一方面會探討不同經文的內容、思想書卷中數個可能會較為突出的課題，更會嘗試欣賞書卷中的文學特色、表達手法、情節的鋪排等等。
