Your BD Action Plan

These nine primes now hold task order authority through May 2034. **Do not send a generic introduction.** Each outreach should be scoped to your specific capability and how it maps to UMS lifecycle work, whether that is precision fabrication, ruggedized electronics, RF/comms hardware, sensor integration, logistics support, or test & evaluation services.

Step 1: Review the original solicitation N6600126R0018 on SAM.gov for the full Statement of Work, map your NAICS codes and capabilities to specific task areas.

Step 2: Identify the Small Business Liaison Officer (SBLO) at each prime above and send a one-page targeted capability statement specific to UMS support. Prioritize Abbott On Call, Astrion, Naval Systems Inc., and Prescient Edge as most likely to subcontract to small businesses.

Step 3: Update your SAM.gov and SourceBoard profiles this week to include UMS-relevant keywords: unmanned maritime, UUV, USV, autonomous surface vehicle, mine warfare, ISR support, lifecycle sustainment. Primes will conduct vendor discovery before issuing subcontract solicitations.
