# A DEVOTION FOR WEEK 2 OF ADVENT: LOVE

#### **CALL TO WORSHIP**

#### **Reflection for Greeting Advent with Love**

We light the second Advent candle, the candle of love, as we look to the coming of Jesus, who brings us love now and forever. In scripture we read, "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God." (1 John 4:7)

**Prayer:** Dear God, we love you because we know that you first loved us. As we light this candle, help us to love each other, knowing your hope invites us to be hope for others, knowing your love invites us to love others. Amen.

**Pause:** Spend a few moments reflecting on a time when you experienced the love of God in your spiritual journey.

**For more devotional time:** Read Genesis 33:1-17, the story of Jacob's return to Esau and the gracious spirit in which Esau received him. Continue to reflect on ways the love of Christ has been shown to you through your ministry with others. Additional Readings: Ruth 4:1-12; 1 Samuel 20; 2 Samuel 9
