PRELUDE "The Church's One Foundation"

WELCOME & Announcements- Grace Wallace, COSSO Coordinator **INTRODUCTION to Worship** – Rebeka Maples, Director of Spiritual Formation

This service may be adapted for a new or re-appointed pastor. Before reading the scripture, the pastor (and other appointed staff) come before the congregation; representative(s) of the church read the parts of the Leader. This is a good opportunity to include others (young and old) in the service.

If you're going to a new church, read along (on mute) with the pastor, otherwise, with the congregation

Leader to congregation: Dear friends, in today's service we are pleased to welcome (Name as) our new pastor.

We believe he/she is well qualified and has been prayerfully appointed by our bishop.

Leader to the pastor: (Name), you have been sent to live among us as a bearer of the Word of God, a minister of the sacraments, and a sustainer of the love, order, service, and discipleship of the people of God.

Pastor: Today I affirm (reaffirm) this commitment in the presence of this congregation.

Leader to the congregation: Brothers and sisters in Christ, as people committed to the ministries of the Church through your prayers, presence, gifts, and service, will you celebrate and support our Pastor (Name) in these ministries?

Congregation: We reaffirm our commitment to support you with our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness.

Leader: "Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (from Matthew 28: 18-19)

Congregation: We give all our praises to the One who came to bring good news, who taught us to pray, and who offers salvation.
