# Joined by Rao Inderjit, Saini nails unions' 'resilient' people, unveils ₹47cr works

Chandigarh: Haryana chief minister Nara Singh addressed a rally in Nuh on Sunday, where he said that the region is "known across the state for its hardworking, self-respecting and resilient people". He was accompanied by Union minister Rao Inderjit Singh. Notably the BJP is struggling to expand in minority-dominated areas of Meow district.

"The soil of Meow always upheld the traditions of courage, sacrifice and dignity. From the First War of Independence in 1857 to the country's eventual freedom, the contribution of the people of this region remains etched in golden letters in history," Saini said. Prior to the rally, the chief minister inaugurated and laid foundation stones for 16 development projects worth ₹47.36 crore. These included the inauguration of 11 projects at a cost of ₹23 crore, and 5 projects at a cost of

₹24.36 crore. He also announced that the Haryana Assembly Budget Session will begin on Feb 20.

"Under the Aayushman Bharat Charay Yojana, around 28 lakh patients received free treatment worth ₹4.438 crore. Free dialysis services started in all govt hospitals and medical colleges for kidney patients. On Feb 11, Day Care Cancer Centers were inaugurated in 17 districts, in the north to six districts, offering easier access to cancer treatment," the CM said. Speaking on the occasion, Union minister Rao Inderjit Singh thanked the chief minister for projects worth over ₹47 crore. He said that since 2014, both the Centre and State governments in tandem for Haryana's development, especially in infrastructure. Referring to the Haryana Orphan Care Bill, he said that its completion would significantly benefit the Tauru. He requested repairs to the Kharu Corridor and to get Gurugram-like development works for Tauru.

Jalandhar: The National Green Tribunal has stayed the desilting of the Ravi in Guruchak, Guma and other villages of Gurdaspur district till the leave of the tribunal, even as the tender proceedings will proceed.



The panchayat of Galhi village had moved NGT against the tender and auction notices for desilting and removal of riverbed material. The state has enacted the Punjab Regulation of Crusher Units, Stockpiles and Retailers Act, 2025 and notified the Punjab State Minor Minerals (Amendment) Policy 2025. This act and policy introduce a modern, technology-driven, accountable system for monitoring, mining and crusher-related activities. The reforms represent a significant departure from the Mining Policy 2023, strengthening transparency, monitoring, and compliance. "The department of water resources, Punjab, has identified

desilting work not to be commenced without the leave of the tribunal. There is little outrage among Sikhs, who are not aligned with BJP however, the Sikhs offer no overwhelming support for the Congress either; instead, many people from the community recalled its bloodied history

## RAVNEET BITTU DRAWS CRITICISM

At mid this debate, on February 7, Bittu visited the BJP office in Amritsar and posted on his social accounts a picture of paying tributes to the late party MLA Harbans Lal Khanna. This attracted strong criticism from scores of Sikh netizens on X and Facebook, who pointed out Khanna's actions in the early 1980s, which included leading a pro-cigarite band, a march in Amritsar in May 1981 to counter the demand for a ban on smoking in Amritsar and for the city to be granted the status of a holy city.

Several Sikh activists and netizens mentioned late PM Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi, under whose watch tumultuous events of 1984 took place, and the late Punjab chief minister Beant Singh in the same line, while mentioning serious human rights violations and forced displacements across the latter's regime in Punjab. The unpopularity of the Congress among Sikhs after Beant's period could be gauged from the fact that the Congress won just two out of 13 Lok Sabha seats in 1996, just 14 out of a total 117 seats in the

Punjab assembly elections of 1997, and did not win even a single seat in the parliamentary elections of 1998. The BJP's loss in the past, which explains the current debate, that if Sikhs had bitter experience with the Congress, they are apprehensive about the BJP. This became evident during the 2024 parliamentary elections, when Sikhs' votes shifted to the Congress in counter-polarisation, as they felt that it could defeat the saffron party.
