Old Business.

Unfortunately the club will not receive a refund from insurance for the Harvest Pull, due to the policy was in place before we cancelled. Our insurance agent was not happy about this from the company since the cancellation was due to weather. We will now call a week before each pull for insurance for each event.

Review and discussion about the chain length again. NAPA hitch height is 16” with 48” chain and our club has 20” hitch height and 60” chain. We don’t have room on the sled for a shield for the shorter chain, and the angle is the same with the tall hitch and longer chain. It will stay the same.

New Business.

Cleaning up of the iron pile west of the showground’s is coming along. Still more to do before we can use that ground.

The 2019 raffle tractor is still a work in progress. More details to come.

There will be a T-shirt quilt made for the shows raffle again this year. Carol Boller and Judy Jecha are working on that.
