We are thankful for your generosity and concern for the people of Haiti. Your donations have helped with the following programs during 2017.



HSA continues to send \$400 each month to cover meals for the children's program led by Genia Bellevue at the Tabernacle de Morija Church in Petit Goave.



Gerneus Dorvilias sends pictures of one of the meetings at the Petit Goave church each month. We are thankful for this Haitian-led outreach of the church to their village. We believe that the children (most of whom cannot afford school) really benefit as they are able to take part in a program and receive some nutrition there also.



Your gifts have also been used to support Hurricane relief and rebuilding efforts in Haiti after the destruction of Hurricane Matthew in late 2016.



HSA provided \$5,000 to Reaching Haiti for Christ in 2017 to help with the rebuild of a school in Bombardopolis that was severely damaged by the hurricane. We also are working with Steve Exantus with RH4CM to provide funding for the installation of a well near the school and church there.

Some of your gifts designated for Hurricane Relief were directed to Little Footprints, Big Steps as they provided life-saving supplies to families in the southern regions of Haiti after Hurricane Matthew.



We also want to thank our supporters who donated supplies as we made a trip to Haiti in April 2017. We were able to deliver useful items to ministries of Vision of Hope in Cap Haitien as well as to our contacts in Petit Goave and Port-au-Prince.
