Our communication team has stepped up their presence to assist anyone needing a tutorial in any of our mobile or media opportunities offered here at Windsor. Maybe we cannot embrace each other, but we can still hear our voices and perhaps see smiling faces.

But maybe you need more than a voice or a smiling face. Please tell me or someone you trust your deepest need and Windsor will do its best to come as close as possible to helping you come through these times. How can we help support you in such unprecedented times?

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues and many stores and businesses are closed or not fully opened, we are aware that there are some among us who could use a little financial boost. It has been decided to expand the reach of the fund to assist some members who have been affected. We are asking that, if financially able, you consider donating above your regular tithe and offerings to help those in need during this special situation. Please know that, at this time, the financial needs of the church are being met by your mailed in offerings. 
