Every Tuesday during the 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Parish, Father will celebrate The Sacrament of the Healing for people who are sick with serious illnesses or conditions, those who will have surgeries and prepare for other serious medical procedures, those who have depression or other mental or psychological health conditions. The Anointing of the Sick cannot be given to children, youth or younger people who don't have any serious medical problem. This sacrament forgives sins and heals the soul, also strengthens the human body and mind in hope of Christ Resurrection. People are encouraged to receive Confession before the Sacrament of Anointing. Please stay in church after the Mass, move to the front of the church and receive every month the Healing that comes from Gods Mercy through Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

St. Josaphat Building and Grounds Update

Dear Parishioners, we will be working closely with the Bishops office about the future of our Buildings.

As January 2022 our plans our following

- due to rectory/office building deteriorating condition and significant heat damage we will move our office to the parish center building.
- rectory, school and convent buildings are going be prepared for demolition, water and gas pipes are going be shut down
- parish center rooms are going to be renovated, prepared for office and parish meetings.
- the church entrance and roof repairs are going be addressed with the Diocese and fixed this year
- after demolition of 3 buildings the parking lot between the church and the parish center will be installed.
- we have been consistently working with the heat system of our buildings

Dear friend with your help and prayers I believe that in two years all is going to be accomplished. Our buildings are going be strong and safe serving our people properly. Above all we will focus on faith and will continue to build up our Catholic identity. I ask all parishioners not to leave our church, continue your financial support and Christian formation. Only your presence and faith can decide about the future of St. Josaphat Parish. If everyone will engage and help we will be great. If parishioners leave, give up helping us priests and stop praying, we are not going to succeed. In January we should receive a second priest who will live at Resurrection parish and will serve as parochial vicar for all 3 of our churches. Thank you for patience, understanding and help.
