We are a water privileged community of over 800 homes, and we own and maintain a boat ramp, a playground, a fishing hole, and a nature trail for the use of our residences.

We are a voluntary resident's association, which means that in lieu of required annual dues, we sustain ourselves through fundraising and by selling keys to our boat ramp. These funds go towards maintaining our properties, property insurance, and our BGE bills. We are currently in the midst of a fundraising campaign to replace the aging equipment at our playground at 9th and D Streets.


