| Ezekiel's Prophecies | Ezekiel 38-39 | A prophecy about the battle of Gog and Magog, often seen as an eschatological event. | The Parable of the Ten Virgins | Matthew 25:1-13 | Another parable of Jesus, emphasizing readiness for the coming of the bridegroom. |
