SDFRW has the responsibility to help maintain and clean the South Dakota First Ladies and First Gentle Exhibit.





The Commander, Captain Pat Moran, described it as it was a tough deployment as all 110 soldiers were tasked with guarding the worst of the worst prisoners that were terrorists.




