Not sure when to keep your child home? If your child has symptoms of any illness speak to your educator before bringing them to care. Here are some guidelines for the illness policy and when to keep your child at home. Educators can create their own individual illness policies.

- ◇ They have a fever of 101 or higher
- ◇ They are vomiting or have diarrhea
- ◇ They have an undiagnosed rash
- ◇ They have a communicable disease
- ◇ They are unable to participate in routine daily activities.
