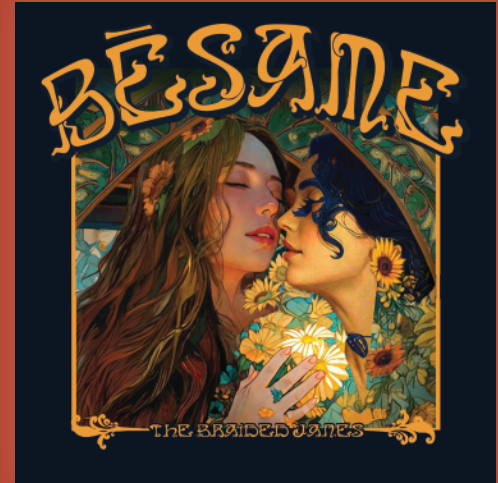

The Braided Janes is a fem-fronted, post punk, latin alt band from Chicago. The trio was founded by family members Jessica "Museica" Rodriguez (vocals, guitar), wife Juny Alvarez (drums, percussion), and brother-in-law Andrew Doyle (bass, electric guitar). Bilingual and multicultural, their statement making music has set them apart as, "one of the best Latin alternative bands from Chicago" - The Advocate and has achieved national attention from public institutions such as NPR and PBS who dedicated a segment to their participation in **Tour Corazon Migrante 2023 Adelante | Corazon Migrante | Season 25**

2023 was a big year for The Braided Janes who released their 2nd studio album, "Renacer" recorded in Minca Colombia with Grammy winning producer Christian Castagno. The "Tropi-alt rock" album was released September 2023, the release show was held at the National Museum of Mexican Art in Pilsen, Chicago where they curated *Noche De Musas II Queer Fiestas Patrias*, a multifaceted cultural event feat. guest performer Niña Dioz. The band completed their first cultural tour Corazón Migrante with performances in over a dozen cities across the U.S including New York, NY, Nogales and Tubac, AZ, El Paso and Houston TX, Kansas City MO, Viola and LaCrosse, WI, Atlanta, GA, Philadelphia, PA and Los Angeles, CA. and ended the year with a SOLD OUT show alongside Aterciopelados.

The Braided Janes are currently co-producing their next album with Grammy-nominated audio engineer and award-winning producer Jeanne Montalvo. Their first single, "Bésame" will be released November 1, 2024 on all streaming platforms accompanied by the music video the same day. Bésame is a love song inspired by the love between singer Jessica and wife and drummer Juny who'll soon celebrate 20 years together. It's a whimsical dance down memory lane. The band recorded and co-produced the song from their home studio in Chicago for the first time, working remotely with Montalvo who provided incredible support. The song was mastered by Margret Luthar making it *their first production fully spearheaded by women.*
