YELLOW BALL TOURNAMENT RULES

- All USGA rules apply. All putts must be holed out.
- You must be a paid member or associate of the Liberty Lake/MeadowWood Men's Club to participate.
- The tournament consists of a team yellow ball competition and concurrent individual flighted stroke play. Payouts (pro-shop credit) will be awarded for the team net competition and individual gross and net stroke play.
- **Entry fee is \$30** when playing in the team competition. Individuals not signed up as a team may be paired with other individual players or may play in the individual stroke play competition. Entry for individual competition only is \$20.
- There will be 3 flights of individual stroke competition. Play will be from the white tees. Any player who meets the LLMW MC "80-80" Rule may choose to play from the gold tees, however there will be a three (3) stroke reduction in handicap per the USGA Handicap System Rule 3-5 regarding competitive play from different tees. If choosing to do so, the player should include a "(G)" by their name on the signup sheet. Regardless, the player must notify the tournament committee prior to teeing off.
- Each player will alternate every 4 holes hitting a yellow ball (i.e., player #1 will hit the yellow ball on #'s 1,5,9,13 and 17. player #2 on #'s 2,6,10,14 and 18. etc.) It is each team's responsibility to determine your team's order of play and write the players' names (and handicaps) in that order on the score card. You must maintain this rotation throughout the round. Put dots on the scorecard for each player's handicap strokes. (Handicaps over 18 will get multiple strokes on some holes.)
- A yellow ball must be used by the player on his yellow ball hole. All other players must use a white ball. No exceptions. If a player hits a white ball instead of a yellow ball, he will incur a two stroke penalty and must re-tee a yellow ball.
- Each player's full handicap (1 or 2 strokes if applicable) on his yellow ball hole will be used for the team net score per hole.
- There are optional gross and net skins games plus deuce pots to be paid based on individual scores. Entry for each side game is \$5. Net Skins are based on net score using the player's full handicap per hole. Deuces are paid for a gross score of 2 or better on any hole. All optional game money stays within each flight.
- Upon completion of your round, sign and turn in your score card to the scorer's table. Please double check all scores and addition prior to signing.

The tournament committee will post all individual scores.

All scores are unofficial until verified by the tournament committee.
