

Liberty Lake / MeadowWood Men's Club Tournament Rules

Memorial Cup - Club Championship

- You must be a paid LLMW Men's Club member or club associate prior to teeing off in this tournament.
- All USGA Rules apply unless otherwise stated in the tournament rules.
- This is a two day cumulative score, flighted individual stroke play tournament. **Entry fee is \$50.** The entry fee includes payouts for gross and net total score, plus flighted gross and net skins and deuce pots each day.
- The field will be divided into 4 flights of equal number of entries. Flights will be determined by handicap index. Gross and net payouts will be paid in each flight based on total two day score. Gross and net skins and deuce pot will be paid within each flight, each day.
- New this year, since both courses now have combination tees, each flight will play from a different set of tees.

Championship Flight #1 - blue/white combo tees
Flight #2 - white tees
Flight #3 - white/gold combo tees
Flight #4 - gold tees

The club "80-80 rule" will not be in effect since tees will be determined solely by flight.

- Players will contact the tournament chairman to sign up for requested tee times for Saturday's round just like we've done all year. The tee times for Sunday will be determined by flights and order of standings after Saturday's round. Flight #4 will tee off first on Sunday, followed by Flights 3, 2 and 1 in that order. Order within each flight will be from last place to first place. The Sunday tee times and pairings will be posted on the website sometime Saturday afternoon/evening.
- Upon completion of their round, each group must text a picture of their scorecard to the tournament chairman for the official scoring. After texting the scorecard, players may post their scores on the large scoreboards like pre-covid tournaments. These scoreboards will be completely unofficial for scoring and used for information only.
- This is a trophy tournament for the yearly Club Championship. In the event of a tie for Low Gross, the winner will be determined by a "card off". Using Sunday's scorecard, starting on the first hole the scores will be compared and the first low hole score will win.
