Memorial Cup - Club Championship

- All USGA Rules apply. Play the ball as it lies. Every player is responsible for knowing the rules. Make every effort to
 eliminate slow play. Keep up with the group in front of you. There will be a course marshal monitoring and enforcing USGA
 Rule 5.6a.
- This is a two day flighted individual stroke play tournament. Entry fee is \$50
- The field will be divided into 4 flights of equal number of entries. Flights will be determined by handicap index. Gross and net payouts will be paid in each flight based on a total two-day total score. Gross and net skins and deuce pot will be paid within each flight, each day.
- Each flight will play from the tees listed below. .

Championship Flight #1 - blue/white combo tees (Females play from the White/Gold combo tees)

Flight #2 - white tees (Females play from the Gold Tees)

Flight #3 – white tees unless you meet the 80\80 rule (Females play from the Gold Tees)

Flight #4 – white tees unless you meet the 80\80 rule (Females play from the Gold Tees)

- Saturday's round will be by tee times per the signup sheet. Tee times for Sunday will be determined by flights and order of standings after Saturday's round. Flight #4 will tee off first on Sunday, followed by Flights 3, 2 and 1 in that order. Order within each flight will be from last place to first place. The Sunday tee times and pairings will be emailed and posted on the website sometime Saturday afternoon/evening.
- Upon completion of their round, each group must first text a picture of their scorecard to the tournament chairman for the
 official scoring. After texting the scorecard, players post their scores on the large scoresheets. These score sheets will be
 completely unofficial for scoring and used for information only. After texting and posting the scorecard, place it in the box
 near the score sheets.
- This is a trophy tournament for the yearly Club Championship. In the event of a tie for overall Low Gross, the winner will be determined by.. "extra holes"!
