Hi Friends,

How many ways can you think of to say "Grateful"? Incorporate all of them into this paragraph!! I am overjoyed to fulfill a life long dream of mine; create a Not-For-Profit Theatre Company with an incredible team, and bring LIVE PRODUCTIONS to the stage.

...And here we are!!

In March, 2020 when Niagara lost the world famous: Oh Canada Eh?! Dinner Theatre, each of us lost a little piece of home.

Alex Titei


