- Any violations of the regulations on the part of any exhibitor will nullify the agreement to occupy space and the exhibitor will forfeit to the Hitchcock Chamber of Commerce all fees which have been paid.
- Exhibitors vehicles will be parked in designated areas.
- Vendors must follow State and Local Guidelines related to COVID-19.
