We have designed a week-long program intended to prepare intermediate and advanced fencers ages 10 and above for the upcoming season. This camp includes:

- 3 training sessions per day
- Group lessons, footwork, bladework, drills
- Supervised electric bouting
- Conditioning exercises
- Camp t-shirt for every camper
- 3 meals per day
- Access to recreational facilities: student activity centers/game rooms, athletic fields, swimming pool, snack shop & laundry (need to purchase a card in order to use)
- Dorms: semi-private rooms (boys and girls separate); lounges/common areas

Cost

\$1,500 if paid by April 1, 2020

\$1,700 after April 1, 2020

All fencers must be USFA members for the 2020-2021 season.

Participating Fencing Clubs

West Coast Fencing Academy, Kaprica United Fencing Academy, Laguna Fencing Center.

Additional fencing clubs (coaches and fencers) may be added later as well.

Coaching Staff

Our camp coaches are high caliber fencing professionals who have each produced outstanding results in both the National and International fencing levels, with alumni including Olympians and World Medalists. All head coaches from the participating clubs are expected to lead classes and training sessions during the camp.

What to Bring/Prepare

- Fencing uniform in good condition: mask, plastron, glove, chest protector (females), jacket, lame, knickers, fencing shoes or athletic shoes with white non-marking soles, 1 pair of long socks
- Fencing equipment: At least 2 working weapons, at least 2 body cords, extra mask cord
- Exercise clothes: At least 9 t-shirts, 4 pairs of shorts, warm-ups/sweats, extra socks and extra sneakers.
- Other clothes: Swimsuits, sandals; warm clothes for night.
- Bedding/Linens: bath towels, pillows, sheets, blankets (size Twin XL).
- Toiletries: soap, shampoo, deodorant, bug repellent, sunscreen; detergent,* blister band-aids.
- Bottled water (or a refillable bottle; there are water fountains available).
- \$100 suggested pocket money for incidentals, laundry and other expenses.

Accommodations and Food

Two campers per room (boys and girls separate). Laundromats available. Three meals per day with a variety of healthy choices, including fresh fruits and a salad bar. We encourage campers to bring reusable bottles for water; water fountains are available at the dorms and in the gyms.

Transportation

Transportation to and from camp is your responsibility. Bus service will be available between West Coast Fencing Academy and the camp if you decide to join. You may indicate your interest by contacting us before July 15, 2020.

Healthcare

An Athletic Trainer will be present on the campus during regular business hours; the rest of the time, the Athletic Trainer will be on call 24/7. **All participants will need to provide proof of health insurance for medical care or emergencies.**

Cancellation Policy:

If a request to cancel is received by May 31, 2020, credit will be issued for full amount paid. If cancelled June 1, 2020 or later, all fees are non-refundable. WCFA reserves the right to cancel a camp for any reason, in which case, refunds will be issued.
