



Partnering Practitioner

Thank you for your interest in Just In Power Kids. You are a vital piece of making this mission become a reality in the world. There is some information you should look through before you make the choice to be a partner with us in bringing holistic modalities to children going through cancer treatments.

- This is a network of holistic providers in the state of Maryland only.
- You will need to fill out an application and submit it to our Executive Director/ Executive Team. This gives us information on location, credentials, fees, availability and how many children per week you can accept into your practice.
- After filling out the application and being accepted as a partner, you will need to sign an agreement to protect yourself, the organization and the child/family. You will get an confirmation email with the partnership agreement attached.
- After we receive the agreement back, you will be placed in the database in your treatment modality category and regional location.
- Each child ,upon registration as a Power Kid, will be allotted a stipend of \$500 and has a choice of which modality and practitioner to use.
- Once the child has been matched up with a practitioner, their therapeutic partnership is independent of Just In Power Kids.
- We will using PayPal as the method of paying the practitioner directly. There are exceptions to this payment method and they can be discussed with the Executive Team.
- After the initial visit, the practitioner will make a request for payment (for the fee for the initial visit) through PayPal. We will receive the request, send the fee through PayPal to the practitioner and then verify with the child/family that there will be continuation of treatment.
- If all parties are in agreement that treatment will continue the remainder of the stipend can be dispersed.
- Once the stipend is used, the parties can continue the therapeutic relationship and it will be at that point outside of any agreement with Just In Power Kids.
- There will be feedback forms sent to the children and families as well as the practitioner to gain insight/ input on subjective and objective response to treatment, outcome measures and satisfaction ratings.

If you would like to become a partner and assist in transforming the healing experience, we would love to have you. We want you to feel as empowered to be part of this partnership as the children we want to help. To that end, Please feel free to ask questions about the process.
