



STONEACRES RULES & INFORMATION

Fishing & Swim Rules

- 4 days only on a swim / 3 days off the lake. (this is applicable across all 3 lakes)
- You cannot reserve a swim.
- You can book two individuals 7 day sessions however these cannot take place within the same month of each other OR consecutively. Each request will need approval of a bailiff.
- Lines must be reeled in before leaving them unattended.
- No fishing from boats.

Fishing Tackle Rules

- The use of 4 rods is allowed.
- No sacks or keepnets.
- Baitboats are allowed.
- No long shank curved, bent hooks or fixed lead rigs.
- No fish to be retained longer than 30 minutes. Only weigh fish in a sling and return to water immediately.
- All landing nets MUST be 40 Inches or over.
- No main line under 15lbs
- All anglers MUST have adequate fish care kit i.e. propolis
- Adequate unhooking mats to be used at all times. If you are unsure if yours is suitable, please contact us.
- No peanuts are to be used, other particles should be prepared properly.
- Use of H blocks is allowed but must be bought in as soon as rigs are applied. All boats & fishing equipment must be cleared away at the end of each session.
- Rigs and bait can be applied from a boat.
- Life-jackets to be worn at all times when you are in or on the water.
- All maggots, Castors, and worms of any description are banned throughout the whole complex.

General Complex Rules

- No airguns, firearms, swimming, open fires or dogs on site.
- Do not disturb/damage the wildlife, vegetation, trees or fences.
- Raking of swims may be allowed, obtain permission from bailiff first.
- Take your litter home or use the car park bin. PLEASE do not leave litter around the lakes as this will not only spoil the complex but also cause pests such as Rats to become a nuisance.
- Members are allowed to drive to your swim, ONLY when bank conditions are suitable and at the discretion of the bailiffs.
- All toilets are to be kept clean and NO rubbish left inside these. If toilets or sinks become blocked please contact us to let us know. Kind reminder to leave these in a clean condition as these are for the use of YOU and FELLOW MEMBERS.

Any person not observing the above rules or in the opinion of a bailiff, acting against the interests of the park, will be banned without refund of any money.

By accepting the membership permit you are agreeing with these terms on your application form.

No responsibility will be accepted for any accidents or damage to any persons or property however it may be caused.

If you are on the water in a boat, you are NOT insured.

We strongly suggest you take out your own insurance.
