- The show committee members or officials will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any animal, person or property, and each exhibitor shall hold them harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings or liabilities arising from any such accident or loss of property caused to or by property or employee of such exhibitor
- No Exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge to discuss a decision or other matters unless he first obtains permission from the show steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.

- Horses must be entered under recorded name of their owners or lessees of record. Registration papers must be available. All Equitation and other classes restricted specifically to junior exhibitors are open only to juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday by 12/01/2025 .
- All pre-entries are due by 8:00 pm the Thursday before the show date, whether by fax, mail, or by hand delivery, all entries received after that time will be charged a one time \$25.00 post entry fee per show.
- At check in on the day of the show, you must provide an open check made payable to Marion Horse Show - Unless prepaid via VENMO. Numbers will not be issued without an open check or other form of pre-payment.
- Proof of negative Coggins must accompany each horse as it enters the show grounds. Tests must be dated within 6 months for out-of-state and 12 months for Massachusetts horses. Please include registration numbers, Coggins numbers and sex of entry on your entry form. Numbers will not be issued without this information!

**THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT NOT TO DELAY CLASSES
DUE TO CONFLICTS AND NOT TO ALLOW SUBSTITUTIONS OF CLASSES OR HORSES.**

- The committee reserves the right to determine trophy/money or placing awards up to 6 placings in each class. NEHC Pleasure Classes are presented a certificate.
- Schooling permitted in authorized areas only. Courteous behavior is expected from all exhibitors.
- All riders are to dress appropriately in both English and Western classes.
- Classes will be split for the canter / lope at the discretion of the judge.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times. - NOT allowed near show ring
- Anyone who shows in a class in which he/she is not properly entered with the show secretary shall be charged double the entry fee.
- Horses entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees, unless the committee is presented with a Veterinary certificate or in Equitation only a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. A full refund of entry fees less a \$25.00 office charge will be made upon receipt of said certificates.
- Once a horse or rider has shown in a class or division it is no longer eligible for a refund.
- Refunds will be mailed after the show.
- To be eligible for an Equitation stake or championship class, the rider must have shown in at least one other qualifying class in the division.

**NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ALLOWED ON PREMISES.**

- Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$25.00 fee.
- Any protest must be submitted in writing to the Show Manager, postmarked within 5 days of the close of the show, accompanied by a non-refundable \$25.00 fee. All protests will be reviewed by the show committee.
- You may pick up a trash bag at the entry booth. Please take home your personal trash, no trash is to be left on the grounds. PLEASE Clean up after your horse and around your trailer. A Poop Trailer has been provided - Please keep the show grounds clean.

DRESSAGE SUITABILITY QUALIFYING GAITS AND CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

1. Horses to enter at working trot, in a counter clockwise direction. Horses will perform all gaits both ways of the ring. Gaits shall be medium walk, working trot, and working canter. Free walk on long rein with horse stretching forward and down to be performed in at least one direction. Transitions into and out of the canter will be called for through the working trot. Horses will be asked to reverse direction at the working trot or medium walk at the judge's discretion. Trot work to be ridden posting.

2. Dressage Suitability Objectives: To confirm that the horse's muscles are supple and loose, and that it moves freely forward in a clear and steady rhythm, with purity of the gaits, and accepting contact with the bit. The horse should show lightness of the forehand and engagement of the hindquarters. Resistance and tension of the horse to be penalized. The horse's potential as a Dressage mount is to be considered.

3. Dressage Suitability Specifications: To be judged 70% on Performance of gaits and transitions, with attention to impulsion and submission, and using the objectives above as reference; and 30% on the rider's position, seat, and effective use of aids.

55. NEHC Western Seat Junior Medal - Riders shall be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are to enter the ring at a walk and will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and just be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. To fill a class, three competitors must show with proper appointments. At least the top three contestants are required to perform a test (Please see NEHC rule book)

NORFOLK HUNT CLUB WORKING HUNTER - *Not Rated - OPEN To Any Horse that has Hunted with Norfolk Hunt Club*

Working Hunter Class evaluates a horse's fox-hunting capabilities: manners, and pace. an under-saddle phase (flat work). Judging emphasizes smooth strides, confident, and a relaxed, agreeable disposition

Pace and Strides: Horses must maintain a consistent, free-flowing pace (an even "hunting pace")

Manners: The horse must furnish a safe, smooth, and comfortable ride, demonstrating responsiveness and an agreeable temperament.

Tack and Turnout

Turnout should be clean, traditional, and conservative to reflect the historical nature of the class.

Bridles: Plain leather bridles (black or dark Havana) with a simple cavesson or flash. No bright colors or heavy bling.

Saddles: Hunt seat saddles with minimal colored accents.

Attire of Rider - Formal or Rat-catcher (Tweed Jacket) attire is suggested.

South Shore Horsemen's Council Year End Awards Eligibility

- In the case of Equitation classes, the Rider must be a member whose dues are paid BEFORE points will accrue for Year End Awards.
- In the case of Equitation classes, Riders must show in 2 out of 3 SSHC Grazing Field shows in the same point class to be eligible for Year End Awards in that class. The affiliated - Hanover Hunt, or Mass Classic show does NOT fulfill this minimum requirement.
- In the case of Performance/Hunter/Pleasure classes, the Owner and Rider/Handler, must be Members whose dues are paid AND the Horse/Pony must be Recorded with SSHC before points will accrue for Year End Awards
- The Hanover Hunt and Mass Classic Horse Show is affiliated with SSHC. Points from SSHC recognized divisions that run at Hanover Hunt and/or Mass Classic will be added to the point totals for SSHC Year End Awards. Neither Hanover Hunt, Marion Horse Show or Mass Classic Shows count for the minimum requirement of 2 out of 3 SSHC shows. Classics held at Hanover Hunt or Mass Classic DO NOT count for SSHC Year End Awards.

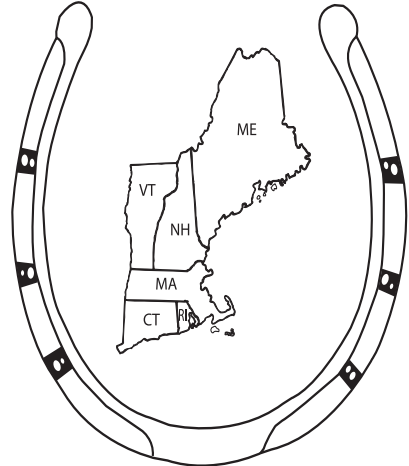
