

# THIS SHOW WILL BE RUN UNDER THE FOLLOWING RULES

- The show committee members or officials will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any animal, person or property, and each exhibitor shall hold them harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings or liabilities arising from any such accident or loss of property caused to or by property or employee of such exhibitor
- No Exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge to discuss a decision or other matters unless he/she first obtains permission from the show manager. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.

# ~~ All Judge's decisions are final! ~~

- Horses must be entered under recorded name of their owners or lessees of record. Registration papers must be available. All Equitation and other classes restricted specifically to junior exhibitors are open only to juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday by12/01/22.
- All pre-entries are due by 11:59 pm the Tuesday before the show date, whether by fax or email, all entries received after that time will be charged a one time \$10.00 post entry fee per person. Prepaid entries by 11/1/22 will receive a free gift.
- At check in on the day of the show, you must provide an open check made payable to Marion Horse Show - Unless prepaid via PayPal. Numbers will not be issued without an open check or other form of pre-payment.
- Proof of negative Coggins must accompany each horse as it enters the show grounds. Tests must be dated within 6 months for out-of-state and 12 months for Massachusetts horses.
  Please include registration numbers, Coggins numbers and sex of entry on your entry form. Numbers will not be issued without this information!

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT NOT TO DELAY CLASSES DUE TO CONFLICTS AND NOT TO ALLOW SUBSTITUTIONS OF CLASSES OR HORSES.

- The committee reserves the right to determine trophy/money or placing awards up to 6 placings in each class.
- Schooling permitted in authorized areas only. Courteous behavior is expected from all exhibitors.
- All riders are to dress appropriately in both English and Western classes.
- Classes will be split for the canter / lope at the discretion of the judge.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times. NOT allowed near show ring (they may be happier at home with the AC on and Barry White playing on the radio).
- Anyone who shows in a class in which he/she is not properly entered with the show secretary shall be charged double the entry fee.
- Horses entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees, unless the committee is presented with a Veterinary certificate or in Equitation only a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. A full refund of entry fees less a \$25.00 office charge will be made upon receipt of said certificates.
- Once a horse or rider has shown in a class or division it is no longer eligible for a refund.
- · Refunds will be mailed after the show.

# NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ALLOWED ON PREMISES.

- Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$25.00 fee.
- Any protest must be submitted in writing to the Show Manager, postmarked within 5 days of the close of the show, accompanied by a non-refundable \$25.00 fee. All protests will be reviewed by the show committee.
- You may pick up a trash bag at the entry booth. Please take home your personal trash, no trash is to be left on the grounds. PLEASE Clean up after your horse and around your trailer. A Poop Trailer has been provided - Please keep the show grounds clean.

## **Division Rules**

**LEAD LINE DIVISION** - Open to riders 6 and under & 10 and under as of 12/01/21. Equitation classes have judging emphasis on Equitation of rider. Suitability classes have judging emphasis on suitability of mount to rider and pleasure of horse.

- 1. Lead line Equitation 6 yrs. and under
- **2.** Lead line Suitability 6 yrs. and under riders under 6 years of age as of 12/01/21
- 3. Lead line Equitation 7-10 yrs.
- **4.** Lead line Suitability 7-10 yrs. riders between 7-10 years of age as of 12/01/21

**HUNT SEAT PLEASURE EQUITATION DIVISION** - Helmet with a harness is required for this division. 17 and under as of 12/01/21

5. Hunt Seat Pleasure Equitation 17 & under

**NOVICE HORSE DIVISION** - Open to all horses or ponies ordinarily used for pleasure purposes that have not won more than 6 first place ribbons in a pleasure class at a recognized show. There are no limitations as to the status of the rider. All seats and disciplines welcome. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog, canter or lope both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance, manners, quality and substance.

- 6. Novice Horse W/T Pleasure
- 14. Novice Horse W/T/C Pleasure

### WALK/TROT DIVISION 10 & Under -

Open to riders 10 years of age and under as of 12/01/21. Equitation open to only Hunt-seat and Western Riders. Pleasure open to all seats. Rider must not have ever been judged in a class at a show in which they were required to canter.

- 7. Walk/Trot Pleasure 10 & under
- 9. Walk/Trot Equitation 10 yrs & under (Stock & Hunt)

### **ADULT PLEASURE DIVISION**

To be shown by an adult at a walk, trot, jog, and lope or canter. May be shown English or Western. May be asked to back. 18 years or older

8. Adult Pleasure W/T/C

**WALK / TROT DIVISION** - Open to riders who have not competed in any other show or competition in which they have cantered or loped in the last 3 years.

- 10. Walk/Trot Equitation 18 & Over
- 12. Walk/Trot Pleasure 18 & Over
- 13. Walk/Trot Equitation 11-17 yrs.
- 15. Walk/Trot Pleasure 11-17 yrs.

**HUNTER PLEASURE OPEN** - Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to status of rider. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness.

**Costume Class -** Costume Class Dress your horse and yourself up in your favorite costume! Audience participation will help to choose best costume! can be lead or under saddle. We do require an Adult 18 yrs or older to lead any horse being shown. Safety first.

16a. 12 years and under

16b. 13 years to adult

**Simon Says -** just like the classic game but on horse back.

17. Simon Says - Walk / Trot

**Apple under Chin -** each rider will hold an apple under their chin, if rider drops apple from chin, they are out....

18. Apple under Chin

**Egg and spoon race –** Carrying an egg atop a spoon, each equestrian rides through the walk, trot. Rider who drops egg is out

19. Egg and spoon race

**Steady Eddi -** Usually performed at the trot, the Steady Eddie race expects riders to hold cups of water throughout the class, trying not to spill. At the end of the pattern, the equestrian with the fullest cup wins.

**OBSTACLE CHALLENGE** - Rider and Horse to complete in a timed Obstacle course. Riders are responsible for completing the class. No refunds will be given to riders who do not complete the class in a timely manner.

- 23 Lead Line Obstacle Challenge 5 or 6 obstacles, 3 attempts at each obstacle. Not Timed.
- 24 OPEN Obstacles Challenge 7 or 8 obstacles, 3 attempts at each Timed and can used gaits of your choice W/T/C
- 25 Master Obstacle Challenge 10 obstacles available. Must complete 7. 3 of the 10 have double points Timed and can used gaits of your choice W/T/C This class has a CASH prize to be announced.
