

• No Exhibitor or person shall approach a Judge to discuss a decision or other matters unless he

first obtains permission from the show steward. Any exhibitor or person disregarding this rule

may be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.

• Horses must be entered under recorded name of their owners or lessees of record. Registration

papers must be available. All Equitation and other classes restricted specifically to junior

exhibitors are open only to juniors who have not reached their 18th birthday by12/01/21.

• All pre-entries are due by 11:59 pm the Wednesday before the show date, whether by fax or email, all entries received after that time will be charged a one time \$25.00 post entry fee per person. We do Offer \$10.00 off per person if prepaid by PayPal by Wednesday @ 11:59pm.

• At check in on the day of the show, you must provide an open check made payable to Marion Horse Show - Unless prepaid via PayPal. Numbers will not be issued without an open check or other form of pre-payment.

• Proof of negative Coggins must accompany each horse as it enters the show grounds. Tests must be dated within 6 months for out-of-state and 12 months for Massachusetts horses. Please include registration numbers, Coggins numbers and sex of entry on your entry form. Numbers will not be issued without this information!

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT NOT TO DELAY CLASSES DUE TO CONFLICTS AND NOT TO ALLOW SUBSTITUTIONS OF CLASSES OR HORSES.

- The committee reserves the right to determine trophy/money or placing awards up to 6 placings in each class. NEHC Pleasure Classes are presented a certificate.
- Schooling permitted in authorized areas only. Courteous behavior is expected from all exhibitors.
- All riders are to dress appropriately in both English and Western classes.
- Classes will be split for the canter / lope at the discretion of the judge.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times. NOT allowed near show ring (they may be happier at home with the AC on and Barry White playing on the radio).
- Anyone who shows in a class in which he/she is not properly entered with the show secretary shall be charged double the entry fee.
- Horses entered and not exhibited shall forfeit fees, unless the committee is presented with a Veterinary certificate or in Equitation only a physician's certificate in the case of the rider. A full refund of entry fees less a \$25.00 office charge will be made upon receipt of said certificates.
- Once a horse or rider has shown in a class or division it is no longer eligible for a refund.
- · Refunds will be mailed after the show.
- To be eligible for an Equitation stake or championship class, the rider must have shown in at least one other qualifying class in the division.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ALLOWED ON PREMISES.

- Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a \$25.00 fee.
- Any protest must be submitted in writing to the Show Manager,
- postmarked within 5 days of

the close of the show, accompanied by a non-refundable \$25.00 fee. All protests will be reviewed by the show committee.

• You may pick up a trash bag at the entry booth. Please take home your personal trash, no trash is to be left on the grounds.

PLEASE Clean up after your horse and around your trailer. A Poop Trailer has been provided - Please keep the show grounds clean.

Entries to be shown individually standing, and then at a walk and trot on the line.

LEAD LINE DIVISION - Unrated NEHC, Rated MHC C, but only 6 & under for MHC - Open to riders 6 and under & 10 and under as of 12/01/21. Equitation classes have judging emphasis on Equitation of rider. Suitability classes have judging emphasis on suitability of mount to rider and pleasure of horse.

To be judged on performance, manners, quality and substance. Unrated NEHC, MHC

DRESSAGE SUITABILITY QUALIFYING GAITS AND CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

1. Horses to enter at working trot, in a counter clockwise direction. Horses will perform all gaits both ways of the ring. Gaits shall be medium walk, working trot, and working canter. Free walk on long rein with horse stretching forward and down to be performed in at least one direction. Transitions into and out of the canter will be called for through the working trot. Horses will be asked to reverse direction at the working trot or medium walk at the judge's discretion. Trot work to be ridden posting.

2. Dressage Suitability Objectives: To confirm that the horse's muscles are supple and loose, and that it moves freely forward in a clear and steady rhythm, with purity of the gaits, and accepting contact with the bit. The horse should show lightness of the forehand and engagement of the hindquarters. Resistance and tension of the horse to be penalized. The horse's potential as a Dressage mount is to be considered.

3. Dressage Suitability Specifications: To be judged 70% on Performance of gaits and transitions, with attention to impulsion and submission, and using the objectives above as reference; and 30% on the rider's position, seat, and effective use of aids. 33. Horses are to enter the ring at a walk and will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and just be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. To fill a class, three competitors must show with proper appointments. At least the top three contestants are required to perform a test (Please see NEHC rule book)

VRH RANCH RIDING - this class measures a horse's ability to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a conveyance from performing one ranch last to another. The horse and ride are asked to perform a pattern that includes changes of gait, extension of gait, crossing logs and lead changes. All maneuvers should be performed as if the horse were being used on a ranch, and the horse should demonstrate a high level of training, relaxation and quality of movement in all gaits.
