# PORT OF MANCHESTER MINUTES

**November 9, 2020** 

## In Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic and Governor's Directive, this meeting was conducted via telephone conference call

#### **REGULAR MEETING**

1.0 Call to Order. Board President Strode called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Present were Commissioners Strode, Fallstrom and Ballard. Also present were Attorney Thompson and Contract Administrator O'Connell. Manchester residents Bill Malmquist, Paul Gilligan, and Joe Guariz were also present. All were present via telephone conference arranged by Dennis O'Connell.

#### 2.0 Approvals - Consent Agenda

- **2.1** Regular meeting minutes for October 12, 2020 teleconferencemeeting.
- **2.2** Vouchers numbered 20246 through 20257 in the total sum of \$5,566.30. After discussion, Commissioner Fallstrom moved approval of the consent agenda. Commissioner Ballard seconded the Motion. Passed unanimously.

#### 3.0 Public Comment

Manchester residents Joe Guariz and Paul Gilligan expressed concern regarding the cost of security patrols at the Port. The FY 2021 Budget includes \$16,300 designated for security patrol expense. Following discussion, it was agreed by all that the Board will continue to evaluate the need for patrols and act accordingly.

**4.0 Resolution 08-20 - FY 2021 Budget -** Contract Administrator O'Connell presented Resolution 08-20, adopting the Port of Manchester FY 2021 Budget.
