| We demand data-<br>driven<br>policymaking                    | <ul> <li>Interim CM Garza did not gather data on ways remote work affects productivity, performance, employee engagement or retention.</li> <li>Garza did not consider feedback from survey respondents who reported increased productivity, better work-life balance, and reduced travel expenses (2023 Affinity Group Telework Survey).</li> <li>Garza did not consider the goals of the <u>Austin Climate Equity Plan</u>, which include         <ul> <li>By 2030, 50% of trips in Austin will made using public transit, biking, walking, carpooling, or avoided altogether by working from home."</li> <li>As a large employer, the City of Austin must lead by example to meet its climate protection and transit goals.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |
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| Telework Changes<br>Must be<br>Postponed                     | <ul> <li>We need time to gather the data necessary to develop a comprehensive policy that will ensure we deliver quality public services while attracting the best of the workforce.</li> <li>By rushing to deliver a telework policy, Garza made an arbitrary decision to reduce remote work to two days per week for most employees, regardless of job title or responsibilities.         <ul> <li>The decision is not backed by data or facts.</li> <li>We can and must do better for the public and City employees.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>                                                                                                                                                                                                        |
