One of the bloodiest conflicts, per capita in U.S. history, and a key turning point in the expansion of English colonization of North America, the King Philip's War took place from 1675–1676 pitting the southeastern New England American Indian nations against the English colonists and their American Indian allies.





PCEI's Enisheetompoag Heritage Tours offer four separate options for visitors to engage: the Mosshasuck Walking Tour in Providence, the Meshanticut Tour in Providence & Johnston, the King Philip's War North Tour in Central Falls, Cumberland, North Smithfield, & Rehoboth, MA and the King Philip's War South Tour in Warwick, Newport, South Kingstown & Exeter. Each tour focuses on geographical sites highlighting locations of cultural significance associated with the Sachem, Villages and Battle Sites of the infamous King Philip's War. Except for the Mosshasuck Walking tour, all times are based on travel by automobile with an estimated 10 minutes spent at each location. Every tour starts and ends at the Roger Williams National Memorial.
