The TollTag may help you save time and money

Many Texas drivers get fed up with the traffic in the DFW metroplex. A simple sticker may help ease the stress of

being stuck in traffic. This sticker is a TollTag from the North Texas Tollway Authority **http://www.ntta.org**. The TollTag can be used throughout Texas on tollways, airports, and some parking lots.

Most tollways in North Texas have switched to ZipCash, where you get billed for tolls that you drive through. The cost of the toll is significantly less if you have a TollTag and you don't have to worry about getting a bill and possibly fines and fees for not paying the bill on time. Taking the side road or access road to avoid paying a toll will only cost you more time, stress, and wear and tear on your car from stop and go traffic.

Toll roads are spread all over North Texas and cut drive time down dramatically. A trip that may take 45 minutes on state highways could take 20 to 30 minutes on toll roads. It makes it simple for getting through the airport without worrying if you have cash or change to pay the airport toll.

Finding a toll road to take to work, a restaurant, or just to a friends house is simple. The NTTA website has a map of the roads and where they take you.

When you setup a TollTag account, you can set it up with your credit or debit account. The service is prepaid for future tolls. When you pass through a toll booth, the toll is automatically withdrawn from your NTTA TollTag account. A useful tip is to check your NTTA account often to ensure that you have enough money in your account. If your account gets low you will need to deposit more money or your credit or debit account may be charged automatically to put more money in your TollTag account.
