**Installation Instructions** 



- 1-Extend awning
- 2-Tilt awning (Per owners desire)
- 3-Lock awning into place (As required by awning mfg)
- 4-Attach strap to awning per image #1
- 5-Apply protector cone per image #2
- 6-Lift protector cone up (sliding strap thru cones center hole)
- 7-Attach strap plate to ground per image #3 or #4 or #5
- 7a-Image #3 (attach using supplied spike)(used in most grounds)
- 7b-Image #4 (attach using twist in spike and/or carbineer)
- 7c-Image #5 (attach using carbineer, mainly for decks/wood)
- 8-Silde protector cone down to ground
- 9-Pull strap until strap is tight and pressure is applied to awning tube.
  - (\*Caution\* Do Not Over Pull)
- \*Take notice to the hold down connection points. Over pulling of the strap may cause ground connection point to release.
- \*Every unit will different on the amount of pulling needed for the strap.
- \*Common Sense will need to be used, if it seem to tight it may be.
