Student Capital Fee (Mandatory)

This 1000 euro student capital fee is mandatory for all students and reflects the cost of classroom consumables, technology, local field trip costs, and other expenses that directly impact student learning both inside and outside the classroom.

Lunch Service - No Fee

Lunch service is included in the tuition fee amount, although may be opted out of by families not wishing to utilize the service.

Transportation Fees (Optional)

Our transportation service is divided into two zones, with Zone 1 serving the city of Split by private bus service, and Zone 2 serving the surrounding areas via shuttle van service. Transportation service seats are subject to availability and allocated on a first-come, first-serve basis. Shuttle transportation requires a minimum of 5 students on a shuttle line for the line to be operated.

Enrollment Fee (Mandatory for New Students)

This one-time 500 euro fee is mandatory for all newly enrolled students, and is payable only during the first year of enrollment.

Sibling Discount

The sibling discount only applies to students enrolled in 1st through 12th grade, and only for the time period in which the siblings were enrolled concurrently. Upon the enrollment of only 1 student, or the graduation or disenrollment of siblings, the sibling discount ceases to apply.

Need-based Financial Aid

Overview

We are dedicated to ensuring that a quality education is accessible to students from all economic backgrounds. Our need-based financial aid program is designed to bridge the gap between what a family can afford to pay and the actual cost of tuition. We believe that financial constraints should not prevent a deserving student from benefiting from the education we offer.

We are able to grant additional need-based financial discounts to the tuition fee of up to 40% of the tuition costs. There are limited discounted spaces available, and not every student who is eligible will be able to receive the discount. Many discounts granted will be less than the maximum of 40%.

Need-based tuition discounts are granted on a 1-year basis, with eligibility for renewal depending on continued demonstrated financial need.

The student capital fee, lunch fees, and transportation fees cannot be discounted.

Eligibility

To qualify for need-based financial aid, families must demonstrate financial need through a confidential application process. This process assesses family income, assets, and other financial obligations to determine the level of assistance required.

Application and Review Process

Families seeking need-based financial aid must complete the Financial Aid Application form and submit it along with the required supporting documents by the application deadline. Families are required to submit appropriate financial documents demonstrating financial need as part of the application process, and need-based financial aid cannot be granted without financial disclosures.

The Financial Aid Committee reviews applications in a confidential manner. The committee may request additional information to fully understand the family's financial situation.

Financial aid awards are determined based on the availability of funds and the demonstrated need of all applicants. Each grade level has a designated number of discounted student spaces available, which is also taken into consideration during the financial aid process.

Award Notification

Families will be notified of their financial aid award via email as part of the enrollment process. Awards are made for one academic year and must be reapplied for annually. The amount of financial aid may vary from year to year, depending on the family's financial situation and the availability of funds.

Conditions for Renewal

Continued eligibility for need-based financial aid is contingent upon:

- Satisfactory academic progress by the student.
- A consistent level of financial need, as demonstrated by the annual submission of required documentation.
- Adherence to the school's code of conduct and attendance requirements.
- Demonstrated commitment to academic honesty and demonstration of development of IB Learner Profile traits.

Students who have been issued pedagogical measures (formal behavioral or attendance warnings) of Tier 2 or higher, which remain in place at the end of the school year (August 31st), are ineligible to receive financial aid the following school year.

Confidentiality

We treat all financial information provided by families with the utmost confidentiality. Information submitted for the purpose of financial aid consideration is used solely for determining financial aid awards, and is strictly stored for the duration of the student’s enrollment in the school. Records of family income and financial information are deleted upon a student’s graduation or disenrollment from the school.

Prorated Tuition

We understand that students may enroll at different times throughout the academic year. To accommodate the varying needs of our families and to ensure fairness and flexibility in tuition fees, we offer a prorated tuition policy based on quarterly and semester enrollment periods.

1 Quarter Enrollment:

For students enrolling for a single quarter, the tuition fee will be prorated to 35% of the full-year tuition cost. This allows families to pay for only the portion of the year during which the student will be attending.

1 Semester Enrollment:

Students enrolling for a semester (comprising two quarters) will be charged 60% of the full-year tuition cost. This reflects a commitment to a longer period of study compared to quarter enrollment, while still providing a prorated tuition fee that is less than the full-year cost.

3 Quarter Enrollment:

Students enrolling for 3 quarters will be charged 85% of the full-year tuition cost. This reflects a commitment to a longer period of study compared to quarter enrollment, while still providing a prorated tuition fee that is less than the full-year cost.

The student capital fee, lunch fees, and transportation fees are prorated using the same percentages as the tuition fee.

The prorated tuition policy is designed to provide a transparent and equitable method for calculating tuition fees for students not attending the full academic year. It ensures that families only pay in proportion to their child’s attendance, aligning with our school’s values of fairness and accessibility, while ensuring that resources are available to support the student’s enrollment in the program.
