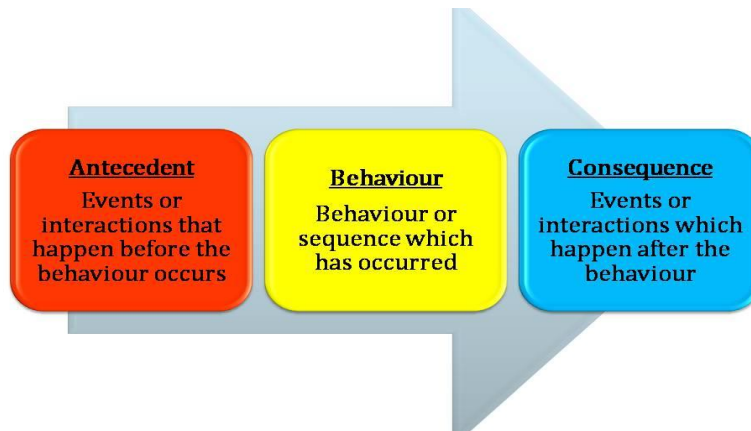




Behavioral Support Policy

2021 - 2022 Academic Year

The Split International School strives to be a positive and structured educational environment that supports our students both academically and developmentally. Students exhibiting behavioral difficulties, either inside or outside the classroom, are to be supported through our Student Behavioral Support Process designed to help identify and document behavioral difficulties, and provide students with the tools and structure they need to develop and grow.



All teachers and staff members have been trained in the steps of the Student Behavioral Support Process. Our teachers seek to understand antecedents to behavioral occurrences, document and classify observed behaviors, and develop a positive and supportive discourse with students around behavioral consequences.

Behaviors are classified into Level 1 (teacher-handled) and Level 2 (office-handled) behaviors. Each behavioral incident has a corresponding level behavioral referral form.
