



Dress Code

Creative movement

Any outfit or costume that your little human may want to wear on the day which can be moved in with ease, and either ballet shoes for C.M. ballet basics or jazz shoes for C.M. jazz basics.

Ballet

Female – leotard, tights, skirt (optional) and ballet shoes. Hair in a bun.

Males – shorts/tracksuit trousers, sleeveless top/T-shirt and 'black' ballet shoes. Hair gelled back.

Jazz/Contemporary

A comfortable top/T-shirt, shorts/leggings/tracksuit trousers and jazz shoes (or socks for +9 yrs).

Female – hair in a ponytail.

Colours are optional.
