



## DRESS CODE

### **Ballet 5-8yrs:**

Female – white leotard, ballet tights, white skirt (optional) and pink ballet shoes. Hair in a bun.  
Males – black shorts, sleeveless Dancehub top/Dancehub T-shirt and 'black' ballet shoes. Hair gelled back.

### **Gymnastics 5-8yrs:**

Female – white leotard, black shorts/leggings barefoot. Hair in a ponytail.  
Males – black shorts, sleeveless Dancehub top/Dancehub T-shirt, barefoot. Hair gelled back.

### **Acro & Gymnastics 9-16yrs:**

Female – white or black leotard, black shorts/leggings, barefoot. Hair in a ponytail.  
Males – black shorts, sleeveless Dancehub top/Dancehub T-shirt, bare foot. Hair gelled back.

### **Ballet 9-16yrs:**

Female – white or black leotard, ballet tights, pink ballet shoes. Hair in bun.  
Males – black shorts, sleeveless Dancehub top/Dancehub T-shirt, ballet shoes. Hair gelled back.

### **Jazz/Contemporary/Hip Hop all ages:**

Dancehub T-shirt, black shorts/leggings  
Jazz shoes for Jazz, from age 9+ socks may be worn.  
Clean sneakers (not worn outside) for hip hop  
No shoes for Contemporary  
hair in a ponytail.
