The Central Texas Pastel Society Board met at the Tiemann Art Gallery in Round Rock on Saturday, July 10, 2021 at 10:00 am. There were 19 members present. This exhibit occurs during 2021-2022, therefore dues for the new year should be paid at time of submission to insure inclusion of entries in the show.

Entry fee is \$25. for 3 paintings, up to 2 additional paintings will be \$10.00 each. Once registration is completed, Exhibit Chair Jan Frazier will send instructions for payment, either on our website using PayPal or a credit card, or the address for mailing a check.

All work must be for sale.

Tiemann Gallery charges a 40% commission on sales.

Art work must have neutral mats.

There will be cash awards, vendor merchandise awards (being solicited by Julie Schmidt) and a purchase award by Tiemann Gallery.

Entries are acceptable immediately. Enid Wood will jury this show online. All members will have at least one entry accepted.

Ann Nelson Sweat, a very accomplished artist, will judge our show for awards.

Ted Keller, a local photographer, has agreed to photograph 5 unframed paintings at \$20.00 for each member on Thursday, August 26 by appointment only.

Carrie Tiemann gave the brief history of the Gallery, her goals for our show, her marketing efforts, and how the gallery manages exhibits. Tiemann Gallery artists rotate every 2 ½ months. Our work will be insured. Each artist will have a signed contract with the gallery. If a piece is sold, a check will be issued at end of that month. At art openings the gallery features live music with complimentary refreshments.

She introduced Heather Letterman, who does the actual framing of art work. Heather explained her techniques framing pastels using archival materials, and the benefits of good framing. Tiemann Gallery has set up a special pricing for framing our pastels with high quality materials. Heather stressed that we sign our pastels at least ½ inch from bottom edge, so the signature will not be covered by the mat. If signature is not legible, sign artwork on backside.
