

Bonfire Edition Fire Pit Kit

Assembly Instructions

Materials List

- ☞ 140 **SOLID** Granite Pavers (10 layers of 14 curved pavers)
- ☞ Metal Fire Ring

Additional materials needed:

- ☞ Tape Measure
- ☞ Level
- ☞ High Heat Silicone Adhesive (optional)

Step 1: Decide on your Fire Pit location. Make sure it's level and clear of vegetation.

Step 2: Decide on your 14 Capstones and place to the side for the final row. You can choose to make your capstones all one type of granite to compliment your decor or create a beautiful mosaic with your favorite pieces.

Step 3: Start building your Fire Pit. Set your Fire Pit Insert in the location you want, start to lay the blocks around the insert with no gaps between pavers. Lay-out your first row of 14 Granite pavers and check for level and proper spacing.. you may need to add a gap between the blocks depending on the exact diameter of your fire pit insert.. After that it's easy, just build one row after the other, staggering your seems. Occasionally check that your spacing is equal and you're maintaining a level build.

Step 4: At minimum, secure the final 3 - 4 rows using a high heat adhesive*. Allow adhesive to cure completely before using Fire Pit. The completed Bonfire Edition Fire Pit weighs approximately 900-1000lbs. **Follow manufacturer's instructions since drying time will vary per product.*

Step 5: Enjoy! Granite is one of nature's most durable and beautiful stones. Your Fire Pit is sure to delight for many, many years to come.

Check with local zoning codes for proper positioning next to structures. This Fire Pit is considered non-permanent
