EVERY TURN, EVERY PHRASE IS IMPORTANT Pastor Burgdorf

In my year and a half here at Risen Savior, I have heard Pastor Weinkauf express many times that every turn, every phrase in the liturgy, every movement has purpose and meaning. What a beautiful thing to realize and confess. When we sit, when we stand, when we speak, and how, it all confesses, it all has purpose.

We bow when the procession passes out of reverence to the office the pastors hold; we make the sign of the cross, in remembrance of our baptism, and confess the name of the Holy Trinity. We all stand and sit, we eat the sacrament. We sing hymns of praise and speak the prayers with our lips. It is safe to say that worship involves our entire being.

Because we are not gnostics. We do not reject the physical. Christ our Lord says: "The hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth".

That does not mean it is not a physical thing. It is indeed good that we engage our whole bodies in worship; this is the pattern of the Scriptures, as they gathered physically in the temple, and it is the pattern of the early church's worship. God has made us body and soul. We are not merely Spirits, but bodies as well. Our entire being should be engaged in worship, our physical bodies being used to express spiritual truths.

Let us then use our bodies in a godly way, to glorify God, to confess His truth. You may have noticed that your pastors kneel during the Nicene Creed. This is a very ancient practice and not reserved for the clergy alone. If you are able, I would encourage you to kneel during the creed, at the phrase "and was made man" out of honor and recognition of the incarnation.

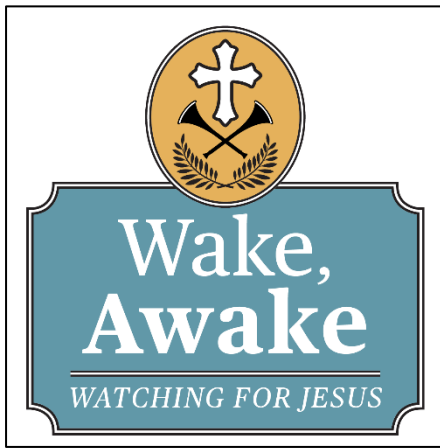
Luther, ever the wordsmith, writes all that needs to be said about the matter in his typical gruff and endearing way:

"The following tale is told about a coarse and brutal lout. While the words 'And was made man' were being sung in church, he remained standing, neither genuflecting nor removing his hat. He showed no reverence, but just stood there like a clod. All the others dropped to their knees when the Nicene Creed was prayed and chanted devoutly. Then the devil stepped up to him and hit him so hard it made his head spin. He cursed him gruesomely and said, 'May hell consume you, you boorish ass! If God had become an angel like me and the congregation sang: 'God was made an angel,' I would bend not only my knees but my whole body to the ground! (Luther's Works, Vol. 22,105)

Whether you kneel or not, let us use our bodies for the glory of God.
