## St. Martin's Centennial by Steve Mariano (Originally published in the Jan 2008, St. Martin Newsletter)

2008 is our congregation's 100<sup>th</sup> year of existence. Organized on April 7, 1908, in the Wallula Christian Church building (located in 1908 on the south side of Polfer Road, in Wyandotte County, about 1 mile East of our current location), our church has been built three times, moved once, had 16 called ordained ministers and 2 Lay-ministers as Pastors, and averaged 98 baptized members every year since its organization. I thought as an introduction to our centennial year it would be interesting to compare the church in 1908 with that of today. Hope you enjoy.

Church Address - Usher, Kansas

96 baptized members

All church records written in German English language services twice a month

Annual Church Income<sup>1</sup> \$208.08

Church was in debt \$500

Offerings taken 3-4 times a year

Kerosene lanterns for light 20 pews in the church

Hot weather? Open windows Pastors salary \$3.85/week

Value of church property - \$3,000

Church, parsonage, barn insurance - \$49/year

Coal burning stove for heat Outside pump for water

3 stall barn for Pastors horse & milk cow

1 hole outhouse

No basement, narthex, office space Church did not own the land it was on.<sup>3</sup>

Church property is fenced to keep grazing cattle out

4 room parsonage - 670 square feet

Elders & Treasurer only elected lay-members

Elders served as Trustees

Only men over 21 could be voting members

Church secretary was the Pastor<sup>4</sup>

Women & men sat on separate sides of the church

Communion conducted twice a year Pulpit - raised above and behind Alter The idea of Sunday School was non-existent Cost for a German or English Hymnal - \$0.35

Sunday Worship services began 10:00 a.m.

No one came to church in a car

Church Address - Basehor, Kansas 97 baptized members in the register All church records written in English English language services all the time Annual Church income over \$30,000

Church has no debt Offerings taken weekly Electric lighting 20 pews in the church

Hot weather? Turn on the AC and ceiling fans

Pastors salary approx. \$650.00/week<sup>2</sup> Value of church property - about \$300,000

Church, parsonage insurance approx. \$2,500/ year

Two gas furnaces for heat

Indoor plumbing with hot and cold water

Asphalt parking/drive for car; milk comes from store 3 commodes and 2 urinals in 3 indoor restrooms Have all plus kitchen, restrooms, storage areas

Church does not own the land it is on

Church property is fenced to keep grazing cattle out

9 room parsonage - 1,960 square feet

Elders & an elected council of 9 lay-members

Elders serve as Trustees.

Men & women over 18 are voting members

Church secretary is elected Women and men sit together

Communion conducted 2-3 times a month Pulpit - in front and to the side of the Alter

Sunday School is customary Cost for a Hymnal - \$20.00

Sunday Worship services begin at 10:00 a.m. No one comes to church riding a horse

- 1. The first full year of accounting was 1 Sep 08 to 31 Aug 09
- 2. Salary and housing allowance only. Does not include insurance & retirement compensation.
- 3. Land was finally purchased in the early 1950's.
- 4. The Pastors knew how to write German, very few members could.
