



#### The Catholic Faith

Whoever desires to be saved, must all things hold the Catholic faith. Whoever does not keep it whole and undefiled, will without doubt perish eternally. And the Catholic faith is this... At His coming all people will rise again with their bodies and give an account concerning their own deeds. And they that have done good will enter into eternal life; and those that have done into eternal fire. This is the catholic faith; whoever does not believe it faithfully and firmly, cannot be saved.

Every Trinity Sunday, churches will use the Athanasian Creed. Two items in the Creed to note. One is the word "catholic" used. This does not mean Roman Catholic; but the word (lower case 'c') means universal -what is true in all times and places, unity in the doctrine of Scripture. The other item is in the last portion refers to those who "have done good...into eternal life." and "done evil, into eternal fire." Note this comes in the Creed following the confession of what Christ has done for us. Of course according to Scripture we hold to salvation by God's grace alone. These Creedal statements are made in light of our salvation, similar to what is spoken by Jesus in the 'sheep and the goats' of Matthew 25. The "good" that God sees in us is the merits of Jesus' work alone; as Scripture shows may places there is not anything "good" we do that can save us.

A catholic faith should be the desire of all Christians, you would think! It lies at the heart of Scripture alone. Not Scripture plus tradition (Rome); not Scripture plus reason (Reformed, Baptist), not Scripture plus experience (Methodist, Pentecostal). It is important to note Martin Luther is excommunicated from the Roman Church, under penalty of death, for being a good catholic. He teaches nothing not based in Scripture and even confessed by the Church Fathers. He desires the Church be more catholic.

Look at some teachings you are bound to believe in the Roman Church; while it may have been taught many years prior, note the year it becomes doctrine.




