**OLD TESTAMENT** **Genesis 18:1-14** *The Lord comes to Abraham and Sarah*

The Lord appeared to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre, as he sat at the door of his tent in the heat of the day. He lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, three men were standing in front of him. When he saw them, he ran from the tent door to meet them and bowed himself to the earth and said, "O Lord, if I have found favor in your sight, do not pass by your servant. Let a little water be brought, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree, while I bring a morsel of bread, that you may refresh yourselves, and after that you may pass on— since you have come to your servant." 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

**Welcome to the Lord's House. The Word of Christ Is the One Thing Needed.** "The LORD appeared to [Abraham] by the oaks of Mamre" (Gen. 18:1) and received his hospitality. Abraham received the gracious promise of a son. Though Abraham and Sarah were very old, nothing is "too hard for the LORD" (Gen. 18:14). His Word appointed the time, fulfilled the promise. In the same way, the Lord Jesus "entered a village" and received Martha's hospitality. "Martha was distracted with much serving" because she was "anxious and troubled about many things," but her sister, Mary, "sat at the Lord's feet and listened to his teaching." The service of love is no sin, but "one thing is necessary" - the Word of Christ (Luke 10:39-42). Thus, ministers of Christ are sent "to make the word of God fully known, the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints" (Col. 1:25-26). **The Lord bless this Divine Service.**

**We celebrate the Lord's Supper today,** in the confession, as Jesus says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread, wine but His very real, true body, blood to eat, drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him, and with one another.
