Once again Pastor said talk with pastors. If your church has paraments that they no longer use you can give them to new mission churches or the Orphan Grain Train will take them.

Missions for today were voted on to go to Spirit Of Life Mission Church, in the North District. South District will send theirs to the Inner City Projects.\$ 100.00 each.
