They are only made of white and gold . White is the liturgical (church) color for Christmas and symbolizes Jesus was pure and perfect. The Gold symbolizes his Majesty and Glory. Chrismons cam be made from nearly anything, but paper and embroidered ones are the most common. The first Chrismon ornaments were developed by Frances Kipps Spencer in 1957.

The 3rd program by Rev. Joshua Errer-Faith Lutheran was on Banners. Having displayed many of the 92 banners they have at Faith church and explaining how some are make and showed how they hang them up.

Open forum: "ask the Pastor" segment. The questions to the Pastoral Advisor Rev. James Schulz were about Communion. When should communion be setup and how are the communion vessels cleaned up.
